If you answered yes to these questions then Certificate III is a great way to start your nursing career.

Learning Outcome

The CHC30208 Certificate III in Aged Care course provides training for aged care workers in hostels, nursing homes, group homes and supported accommodation services. This course aims at teaching students the knowledge and skills required to carry out activities relating to personal care/activities of living whilst maintaining the rights of the residents and maximizing their independence.

Target Group

This course is offered to persons wishing to pursue a career in nursing (learning and assessment pathway) or those who are already experienced in this vocational area and wish to seek formal recognition for their existing skills (assessment only pathway)

Entry Requirements

There are no pre-requisite Units of Competency required to enroll in this course however applicants must:-

- Be 16 years of age or over
- Have satisfactorily completed the School Certificate or equivalent
- Have basic written and spoken English skills
- Have a current Australian Federal Police Clearance

Course Duration

The CHC30208 Certificate III in Aged Care course consists of a combination of workplace and institution based training and assessment totalling approximately 600 hours. Face to face training is delivered over 9 weeks (36 classroom days) totalling 270 hours. Students participate in an additional 135 hours clinical placement in various aged care facilities following an orientation day and manual handling demonstration. Students are also required to complete written assessments & course revision over the duration of the course (home study) for approx 180 hours.

Course Contents

This course is organised into 14 units of competency, made up of ten core units and four elective units. Each Unit of Competence is grouped into “Skills Sets” which refer to the skills needed to accomplish a specified task or perform a given function.

Clinical placement is done throughout the course in Weeks 4, 7, 10 and 13 (Mon to Fri - AM shifts only)

HLTFA301B – Apply Senior First Aid is delivered in partnership with Vital First Aid Training Services

N.B. Certificate III in Aged Care training includes clinical placement in an Aged Care Facility. During this component students will be required to have physical contact with Aged Care residents. This will include maintaining residents Activities of Living (ADL's) such as showering, dressing/undressing and toileting residents as required. Students must feel comfortable with this prior to enrolling in this course.
